The University of Ottawa's services for Congress 2015 attendees

Staying in residence

The University of Ottawa is looking forward to hosting the 2015 Congress of the Humanities and Social Sciences and welcoming all attendees in May. Our beautiful campus is located in the heart of the nation's capital, with nature at its doorstep and bordering the historic Rideau Canal.

To accommodate the high volume of Congress attendees, the University of Ottawa is offering over 1,300 beds for the conference attendees in six different residences.

Types of accommodations

The University will be offering three styles of residence accommodations: traditional style, suite style and studio style. Attendees will have the option of choosing on-campus or off-campus residences.

On-campus residences

Traditional-style residences are equipped with both single and double rooms, with communal kitchen and lounge, and separate gendered washroom areas.

90 University suite-style residence (90U) offers double-occupancy rooms. In 90U, there is a separate bedroom with double bed for each guest and a shared kitchen area in the unit which includes fridge, sink and microwave (utensils and kitchenware not included).

Off-campus residences

The Friel Residence building is about a 10-minute walk from campus.

Friel suite-style accommodations offer a one bedroom with two single beds, private washroom and kitchenette amenities with sink, mini-fridge, microwave and cupboards (utensils and kitchenware not included).

Friel studio-style accommodations are similar to single rooms or double rooms in traditional style but with a private washroom in each unit. Many studio-style rooms also include a kitchenette with sink, mini-fridge and cupboards (utensils and kitchenware not included).



Key facts and information:

- Wi-Fi internet is available in every residence.
- Bed linens and towels will be provided in every room.
- Basic toiletries included (shampoo, conditioner and soap).
- There are many options to enjoy breakfast both on and near campus. **Note that breakfast is not included in your room rate.**
- Air-conditioning is available in suite and studio-style residences only; it is not available in traditional style.
- Front desk open 24 hours.
- Check-in at **16:00**; check-out at **10:30**.
- Luggage storage available onsite.
- Laundry facilities available onsite.
- We accept Canadian cash, Visa, MasterCard and Debit card payments. A credit card is required to reserve your room, and the full payment is taken at the time of booking.

Accessibility

Recreational services and additional services on campus

Attendees are welcome to use our fitness areas, located at the Montpetit Hall and the Minto Sports Complex Facility. Take a dip in the Olympic size pool (50 x 18 meters) or use the equipment at your disposal at the multiple training centers and at various other facilities. These facilities are open to Congress attendees at a cost of \$5 plus tax per activity.

For children aged 6 months to 5 years of age, the University of Ottawa, in partnership with the Bernadette Child Care Centre, will be offering child minding services for Congress attendees.
